

Creating and Logging Into Your Medicare.gov Account

Step-by-step guide to setting up and accessing your Medicare.gov account.

medicare.gov

- You will need a Medicare.gov account to view your coverage, make Part B premium payments, and set up Medicare Easy Pay. Save your login details — you will use this account regularly.

Before you start: Have your **Medicare number** and **Part A coverage start date** ready (found on your red, white, and blue Medicare card). You will also need access to your phone or email for 2-step verification.

Creating Your Account

- 1** Visit <https://www.medicare.gov>
Click **Log In / Create Account** and select **Medicare** to continue.
- 2** Click **“Create Account With Medicare.gov.”**
If you already have an account, enter your username and log in — skip ahead to the **Logging Back In** section below.
- 3** **Enter your Medicare information.**
Enter your **Medicare number** and **Part A coverage start date**. If you don't have your Part A start date, click **Get Other Options** and select Part B. Click **Next**.
Enter your **Last Name, Date of Birth, Zip Code, and Email**. Check the confirmation box and click **Next**. Create a unique **username and password**, select a **security question and answer**, then click **Create Account**.

Logging Back In

- 4** **Log back into your account.**
Once your account is created you will see a green **“You're All Set!”** confirmation. Enter your **username**, then your **password**. Check the **“I'm not a robot”** box if prompted.
- 5** **Complete 2-step verification.**
Select your preferred verification method (phone or email) and click **Continue**. Enter your phone number or email address and click **Text My Code** (or **Email**). Enter the verification code and click **Confirm**.
- 6** **You will be redirected to log in one more time.**
Enter your **username** → click **Continue**. Enter your **password** → click **Log In**. Enter the new **verification code** → click **Login**. You will now have full access to your Medicare.gov account.

What you can do once logged in

View your Medicare coverage details, make **Part B premium payments**, set up **Medicare Easy Pay** for automatic monthly deductions, and download official Medicare documents.

Save your login credentials

Store your **username and password** in a safe place. You will use this account regularly for premium payments and coverage updates — lost credentials can take time to recover.
